

Maricopa County Libertarian Party – Minutes of March 8, 2021 Meeting

The Maricopa County Libertarian Party met via Zoom on Monday evening, March 8, 2021. Sixteen individuals were present, including four of the five officers. The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. The following topics were discussed:

I. Secretary's Report

Secretary Emily Goldberg presented minutes of the February 8, 2021 meeting. The minutes were adopted without revision.

II. Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Robert Allen Pepiton presented the Treasurer's report. The month-ending bank balance was \$3024.02. Deposits of \$51.68 were received. There were no expenses.

III. Chair's Report

Chair Brandon Slayton presented the Chair's Report, including the following:

A. Election Audit Lawsuit:

The party had attended two hearings on the election audit lawsuit. The county was frankly unprepared at the first hearing, which was rescheduled for approximately a week later. At the second hearing, the Judge had first encouraged the attorneys to meet with each other and propose a salutation, but the county the argued that the meeting was moot. Our Response to the County's Motion to Dismiss is due on 3/09; Michael Kielsky will file the Response. The next hearing was scheduled for March 16.

B. Logic & Accuracy Test – Goodyear Municipal Election

Chair Brandon S. reported on attending the Logic & Accuracy test for the Goodyear Municipal Election (an all mail-in election, scheduled for March 9).

C. MCLP PCM Roster

Chair Brandon S. reported on submitting 13 new PCM appointments to the Board of Supervisors and welcomed the new PCMS, whose terms end in 2022.

D. Meeting Procedure/Venue

Chair Brandon S. facilitated discussion on resumption of in-person meetings, location, and potential for in-person meetings with a digital component (via Streamyard or similar). Alexander DiBenedetto volunteered to coordinate technical set-up of the

hybrid meetings when they are scheduled. Further discussion ensued concerning benefit of online meetings for business only, and in-person meetings for more social/events purposes.
